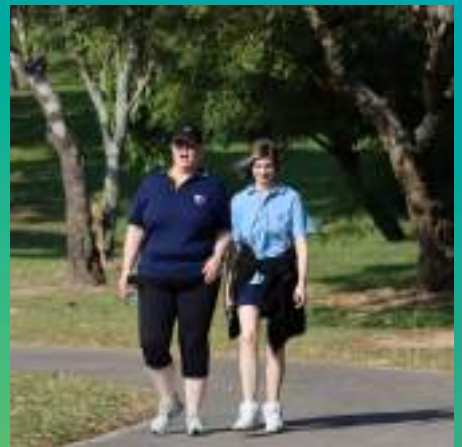
On Wednesday students, teachers and parents participated in our annual Walkathon. All the children belonging OPERATION SMILE are saying thank you!
