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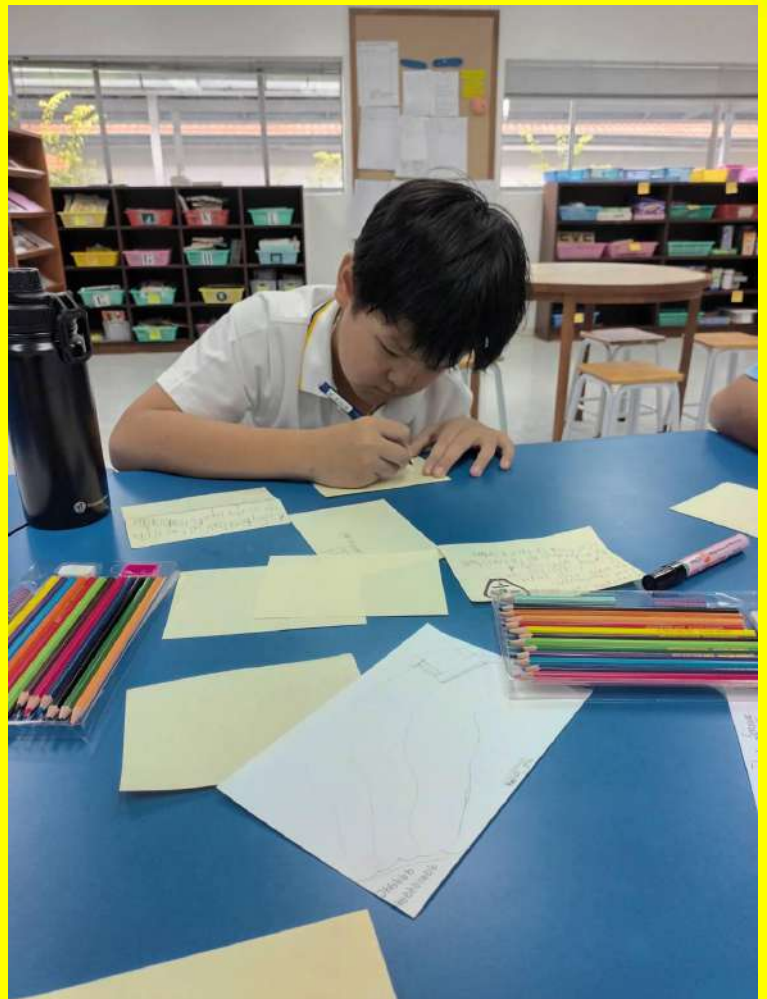
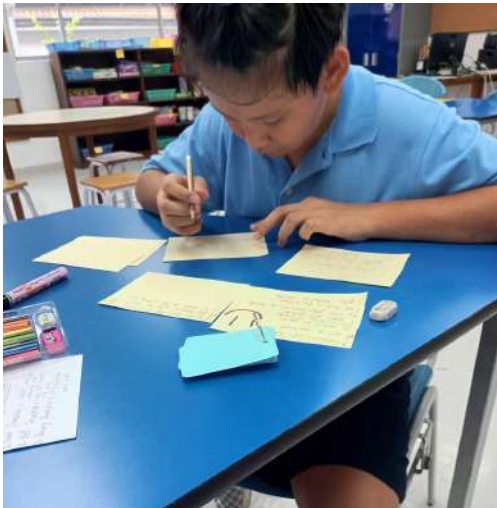
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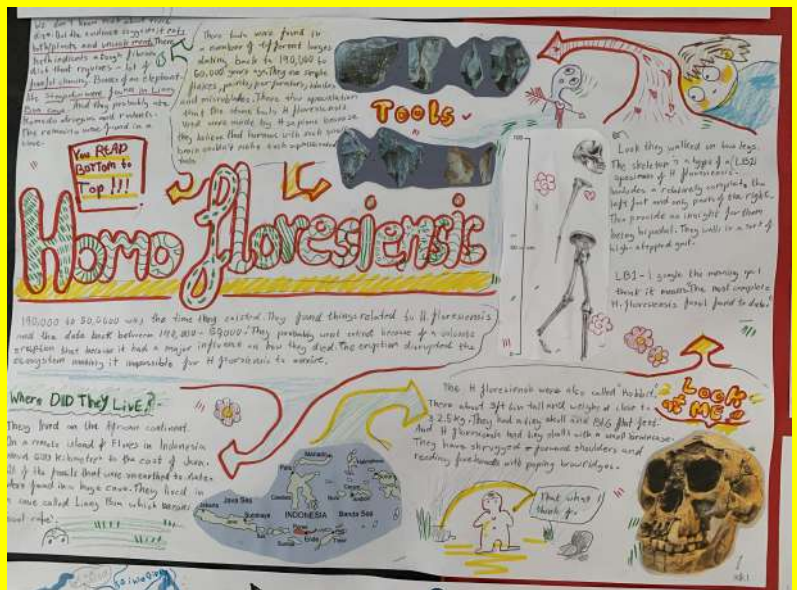
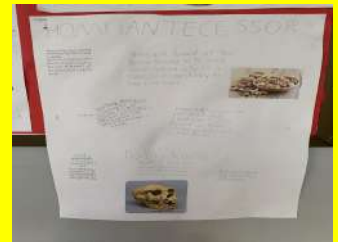
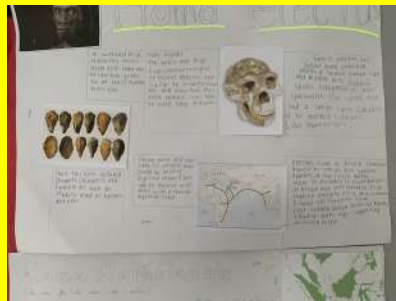
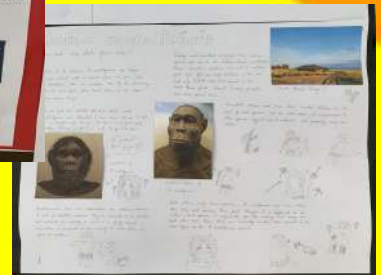
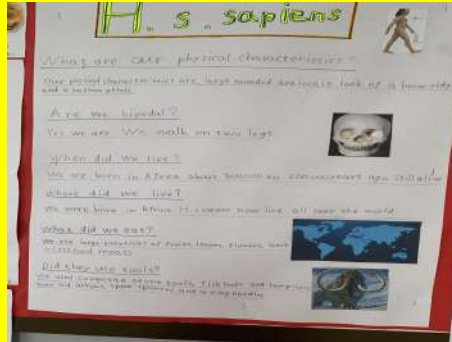
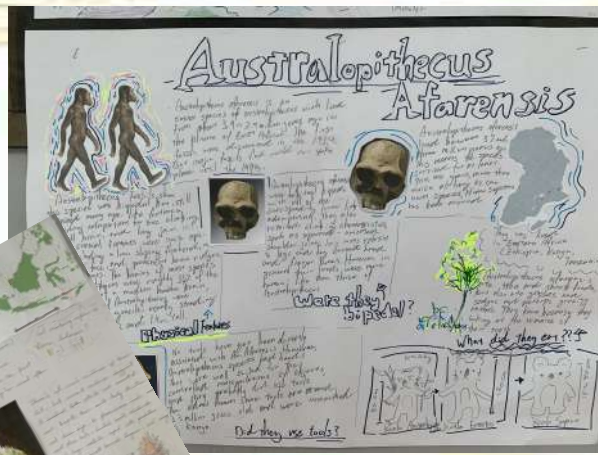
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Games provide an excellent platform for learning, especially for young children. Last Friday, the kindergarteners at our school explored an engaging method to grasp numbers 1 through 100 by playing hopscotch. This playful activity not only introduced numbers but also allowed the first graders to reinforce their existing knowledge while assisting the younger ones. The collaboration between grades showcased a thoughtful initiative by the teachers, promoting an enjoyable learning experience that encourages children to develop a strong connection with numbers.



Elementary EAL: Fourth and fifth grade EAL students write sentences in response to discussions and prompts on a variety of topics. Following this, they illustrate the sentences they've created. Doing this helps integrate visual and verbal encoding systems within the brain.



In grade 6 social studies the students have been learning about the early forms of humanity. Student researched two types of early human forms and created a poster that explains their diet, physical features, if they used tools, and where their remains were found.



As part of our study on cultural traditions in the IB Experience and Celebrations unit, our 11th-grade students dove into a lively tradition from Spanish-speaking countries known as 'Las Pinatas.' They researched the origins, when and how they're used, and the art of constructing these colorful creations. Applying their creativity, they designed and made their very own pinatas. To culminate this learning journey, we celebrated a student's birthday by smashing the pinata in the traditional manner.
